

Driving Instructions to the Hawaii Oil Spill Response Center

From Airport to Spill Center

Upon leaving baggage claim you may take either the elevated highway which leads to Nimitz Highway, or the grade level right turn directly onto Nimitz Highway. Continue east bound on Nimitz Hwy. One of the first major intersections you will encounter is the right turn only opportunity to turn onto Sand Island Access Road. Turn right. The Hawaii Oil Spill Response Center is down this road two blocks on your left side. It is next door, mountain side, of the Union 76 gas station.

From Airport to Downtown

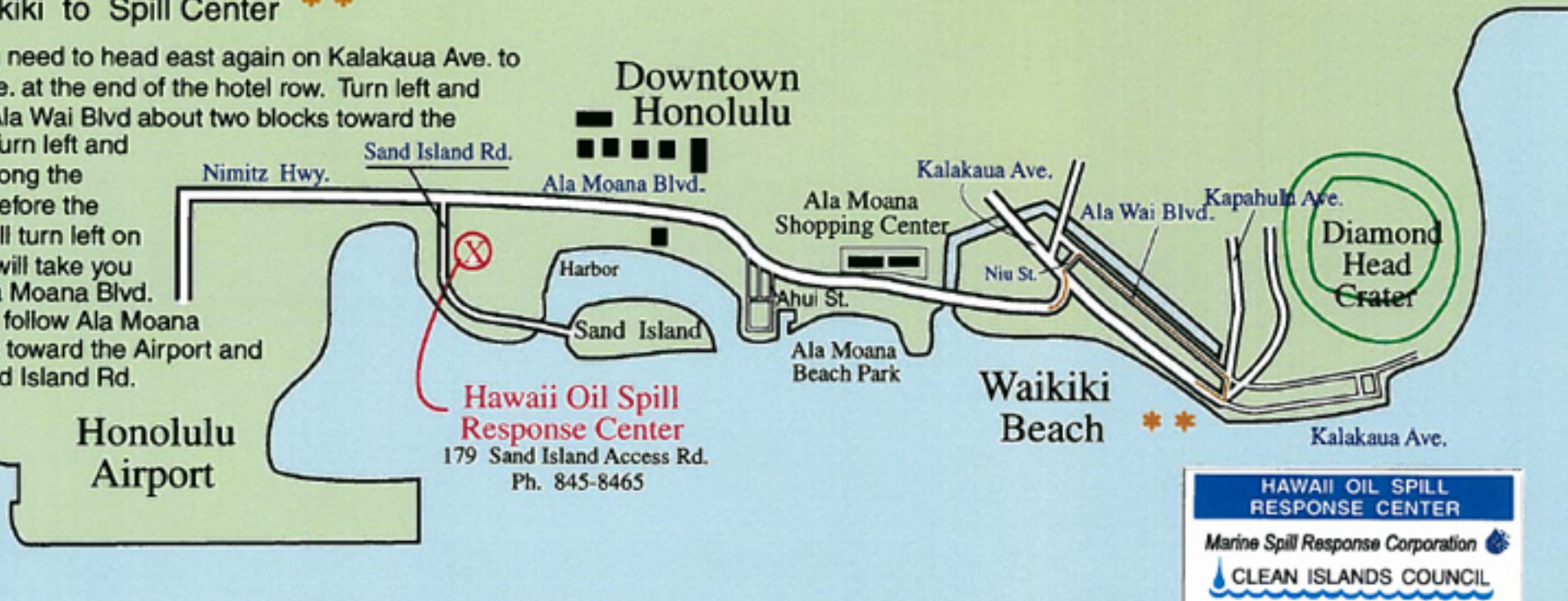
Upon leaving baggage claim turn right to get on to Nimitz Highway. Continue on Nimitz Highway through the Kalihi and Kapalama industrial areas. Upon reaching harbor views on your right you will be entering downtown Honolulu. The heart of downtown is at the foot of Bishop Street located in the tall buildings area. By turning left toward the mountains on Alakea St. you will enter the downtown area.

From Downtown to Spill Center

From the downtown business district head toward the ocean. The main highway along the coast is named Nimitz Highway when heading toward the Airport (west) of Bishop Street. Bishop street is the main mountain to ocean roadway in the downtown district. Travel toward the airport on Nimitz Highway until you reach Sand Island Access Road. Turn left toward the ocean and the Hawaii Oil Spill Response Center is approximately two blocks down on your left. It is located immediately next door, mountain side, of the Union 76 gas station.

From Waikiki to Spill Center * *

Basically you need to head east again on Kalakaua Ave. to Kapahulu Ave. at the end of the hotel row. Turn left and proceed to Ala Wai Blvd about two blocks toward the mountains. Turn left and travel west along the canal. Just before the bridge you will turn left on Niu St. This will take you back to Ala Moana Blvd. From here follow Ala Moana Blvd. back toward the Airport and Sand Island Rd.
